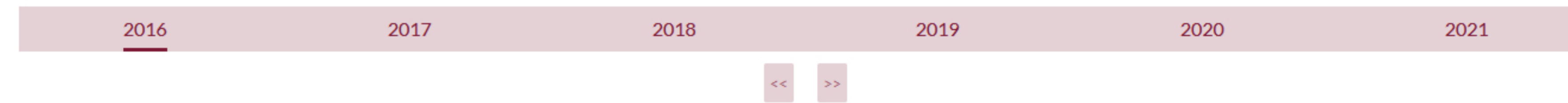

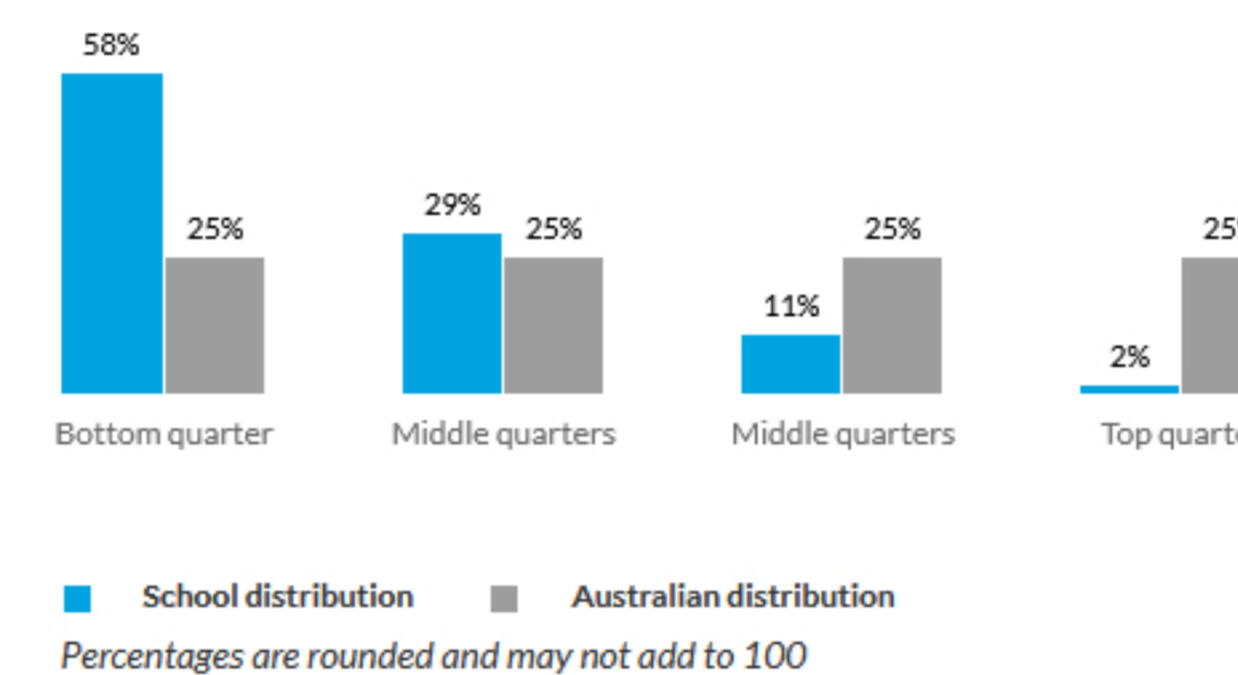

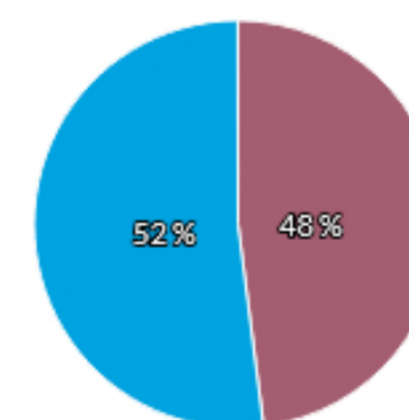
Distribution of Socio-Educational Advantage (SEA)

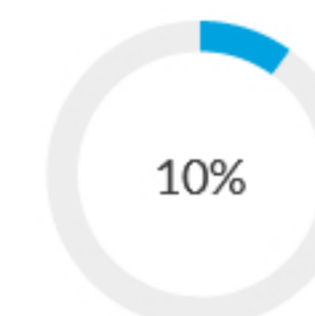

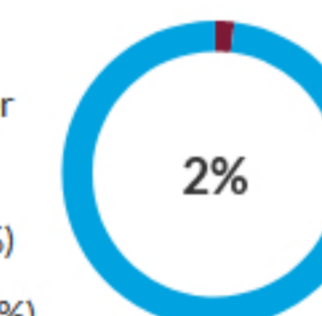
